We hope this communication finds you and your families in good health and you are finding ways to appreciate the summer. We are extremely excited about welcoming the return of our students to school on Wednesday, September 8, 2021. We are also pleased to announce that all students are expected to attend school in-person for a full day of learning during the 2021-22 school year

We are excited to welcome our students to full in-person instruction during the 2021-2022 school year at Paul Robeson Community School For The Arts! As we begin the new school year, it is expected that all students arrive at school on time (8:50 am) daily and ready to engage in learning. We will continue to build upon our School Wide theme of Arts Integration across the curriculum. Finally, our teachers are looking forward to meeting and working with all students and ensuring a successful academic year for all.

Below, you will find some important information for the 1st Day of School:

- **All kindergarten classes should use the Comstock entrance from the parking lot upon arrival.**
- **All first through third grade classes should use the Paul Robeson BLVD entrance upon arrival.**
- **All fourth through eighth grade students should use the Throop Avenue entrance upon arrival.**
- **The first two days of school, September 8th and 9th, are early dismissal days. Students will be dismissed at 1:40 p.m.**

Please review the following information:

- **Arrival Times:** Students should arrive at school at 8:50 a.m. Do not drop students off before this time, as there will not be any staff members available to watch students prior to 8:50 a.m.
- **Dismissal Times:** Students are dismissed from school on Regular Days at 3:15 p.m. Students are dismissed at 1:40 p.m. on Early Dismissal Days.
- **Dismissal Procedures:** Kindergarten students will be dismissed from their classrooms. Students in grades 1-2 will be dismissed on the Comstock side of the building. Students in 3rd grade will be dismissed on Paul Robeson Blvd. Students in grades 4-8 will be dismissed on the Throop Avenue side of the building. **(dismissal procedures have not changed)**
- **Breakfast & Lunch:** Breakfast is served to all students in the homeroom. Homeroom takes place from 8:50 a.m. - 9:15 a.m. Lunch is provided for all students between 11:10 a.m. - 1:15 p.m.
- **Boys' Dress Code Policy:**
  - Polo Shirts (3 buttons/long or short sleeve) Light Blue/Dark Blue, or White.
  - Dress Pants: Navy Blue/Khaki
- **Girls' Dress Code Policy:**
  - Polo Shirts (3 buttons/long or short sleeve) Light Blue/Dark Blue, or White.
  - Dress Pants/Skirts/Jumper: Navy Blue/Khaki

**In order to ensure the safety and security of all students, we have included a packet with various forms that need to be completed. Please return these documents to your child's teacher as soon as possible. In addition, ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED to WEAR SCHOOL UNIFORM as indicated.**

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Queridos padres y tutores,

Me gustaría darles la bienvenida al año escolar 2021-2022 en la Escuela Paul Robeson! A medida que entramos en nuestro segundo año en Paul Robeson, continuaremos construyendo sobre nuestro tema de Artes integración en el currículo.

**A continuación, encontrará información importante para el primer día de escolar:**

- Todas las clases de Kindergarten y primer grado deben presentarse en la sala de usos múltiples al llegar.
- Todas las clases de segundo, tercer, cuarto y quinto grado deben presentarse al Gimnasio al llegar.
- Todas las clases de los estudiantes de secundaria del sexto al octavo grado deben presentarse a sus salones en el tercer piso.
- Los primeros dos días de clases, **8 y 9 de septiembre**, son días de salida temprana. Los estudiantes saldrán a la 1:40 p.m.

**Revise la siguiente información:**

- **Horario de Llegada:** Los estudiantes deben llegar a la escuela antes de las 8:40 a.m., pero no antes de las 8:30 a.m. No habrá miembros del personal disponibles para vigilar a los estudiantes antes de las 8:30 a.m.
- **Procedimientos de Llegada:** Los estudiantes pueden entrar desde la Avenida Throop y entrar en el edificio.
- **Tiempos de salida:** Los estudiantes salen de la escuela en días regulares a las 3:15 p.m y a las 1:40 p.m. en los días de Salida Temprana.
- **Procedimientos de salida:** Los estudiantes de Kindergarten serán despedidos de la aula. Los estudiantes en los grados 1er-2do serán despedidos en el lado Comstock del edificio. Los estudiantes de 3er grado serán despedidos en Paul Robeson Blvd. Los estudiantes en los grados 4-8 serán despedidos en el lado de Avenida Throop del edificio.
- **Desayuno y almuerzo:** El desayuno se sirve a todos los estudiantes en el salón entre las 8:50 a.m. - 9:10 a.m. El almuerzo para todos los estudiantes es entre las 11:10 a.m. - 1:10 p.m.
- **Código de vestimenta de los niños(a):**

  - o Pantalones de vestir: azul marino / caqui Vestido Pantalones / Faldas / Punte: Azul Marino / Caqui
